This will be our second Board Meeting of the term and will once again be held at 5.30 pm. As is always the case, everyone is welcome to attend.

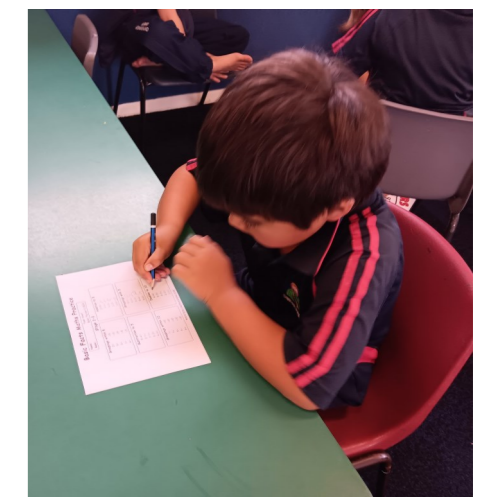
TE KAWAU CROSS COUNTRY
