Term four's outline has been included with this newsletter. As is always the case, things may change slightly depending on circumstances.

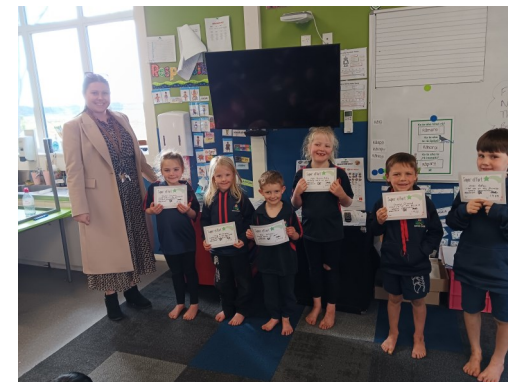
### **Ag Day Entries close on Wednesday 20th September**
