Year 5-6's won 11-0 vs Lytton Street School —Players of the day were Anja Marshall & Harrison Philips.

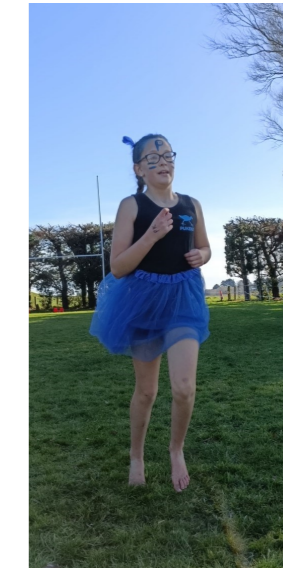
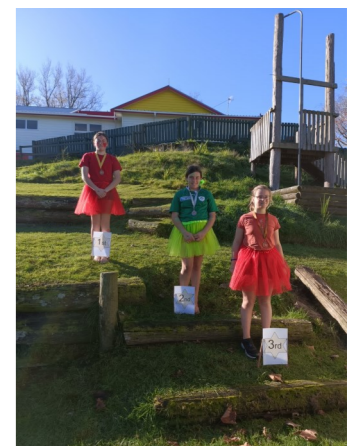
